AWARD CATEGORIES

Adolphus Lee Poetry Award

(1 poem may be submitted)

Charles Matusik Fiction Award

(1 short story, not to exceed 3000 words)

Lou Rivers Drama Award

(1 one-act play, not to exceed 3000 words)

Graphic Text Award

(1 original, multi-frame text that combines storytelling and illustration, as in a graphic novel or comic book. Fiction or non-fiction)

Alan Kay Award

(1 analysis of a text, not to exceed 1500 words)

Judith Walter Personal Essay Award

(1 autobiographical narrative, not to exceed 1500 words)

E.B. White Award for Best Essay on New York including a subcategory honoring a student currently enrolled in an ESOL course

(not to exceed 1500 words)

Michele Forsten Advocacy Award

(for writing, in any genre, that advocates the importance of equal rights, not to exceed 1500 words)

Charles Hirsch Faculty & Staff Award

(Poetry, Fiction, & Essay Prizes)
