Roebling: Before the Bridge

The Brooklyn Bridge is arguably the most significant engineering achievement of the 19th century and the name Roebling is tied to its creation. But what technological innovations evolved over the course of the design and construction of the projects that came before? While there are historical accounts of the more significant work of Roebling, there is limited publication of archival drawings and writings that focus on the evolution and innovation of their construction. "Roebling: Before the Bridge," a chronological review of the body of work of Roebling that preceded the construction of the Brooklyn Bridge, seeks to focus on the value of these early works.
