In this presentation, we will discuss our teaching collaboration in the interdisciplinary course History of the Theatre: Stages and Technology. In the class students work on a research and design module in digital mapping that integrates skills and knowledge from architecture tech and theatre historiography. Students have contributed to the construction of a massive archive of images and historical information, which is now embedded in an interactive GIS mapping tool. The map offers a striking visual account of the development of performance culture over the last two centuries.
