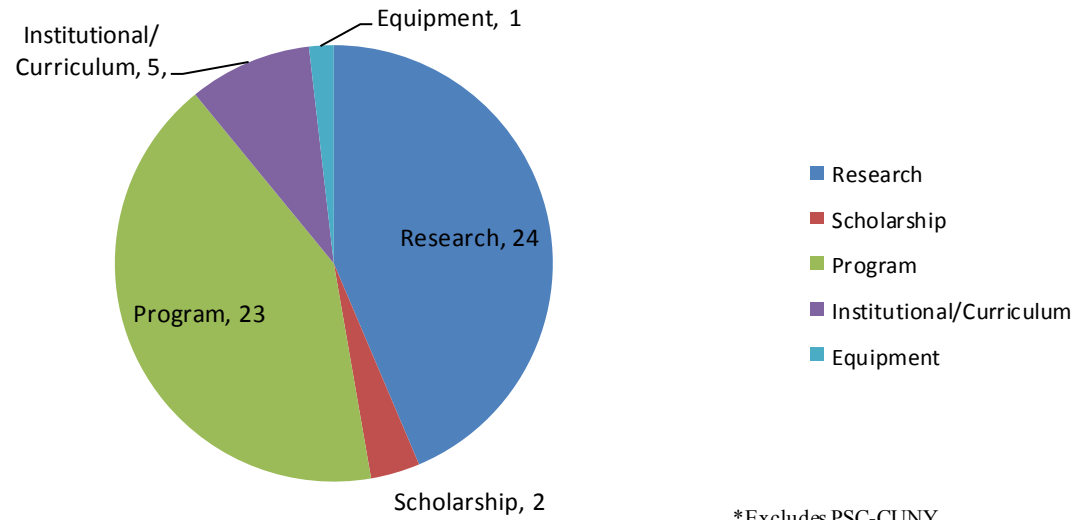

## FY 2011 Number of Grant Proposals Submitted by Focus\*

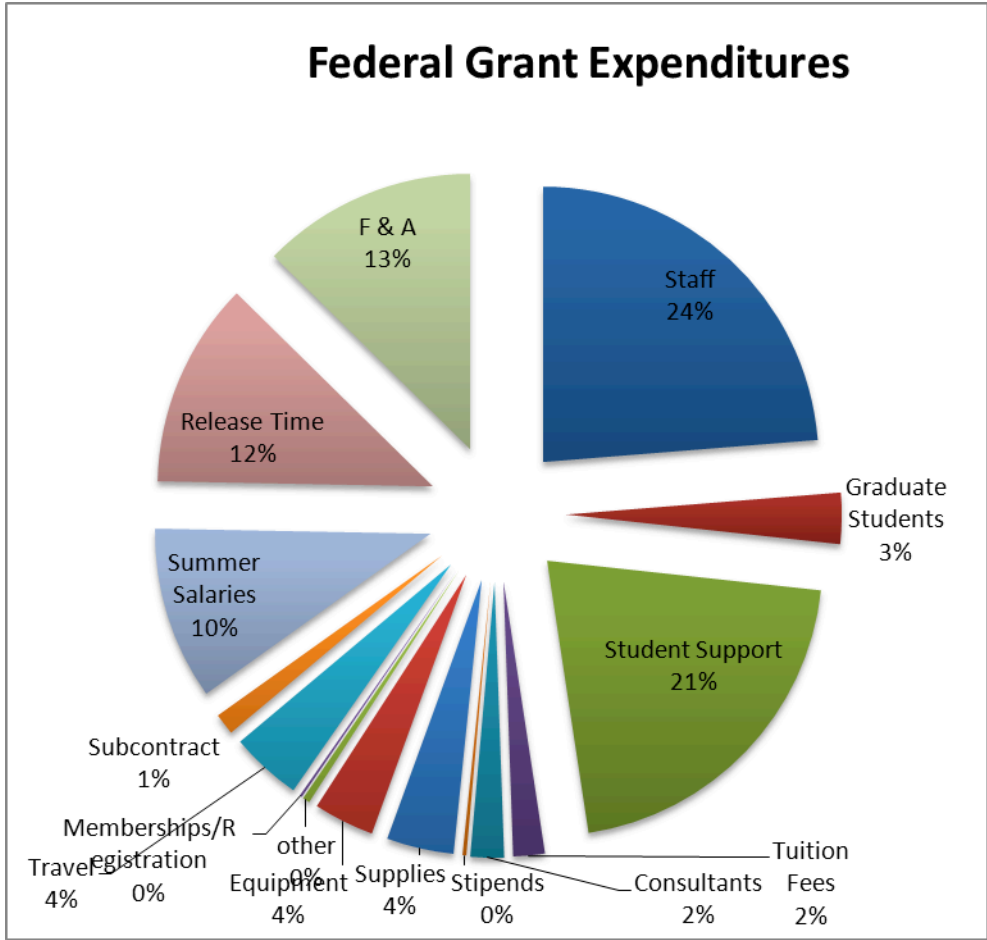
