



Honors Credit in a Regular Course Contract

New York City College of Technology (City Tech) encourages students who have demonstrated high academic achievement to undertake Honors-level work in any appropriate course. Honors work normally involves substantial independent research and/or projects in addition to the normal requirements of the course. Specific expectations for this contract must be negotiated between the student and professor and approved by both the department chairperson and the Honors Scholars Program Director. Honors credit is noted on the official transcript as "HONORS PROJECT" followed by the course and semester.

This contract must be completed and signed by the student, professor, department chairperson, and the Honors Scholars Program Director. It should be submitted four weeks after the first day of class to the Honors Scholars Program Coordinator. In order to receive Honors credit designation on his/her official transcript, the student is required to complete three online modules, present the Honors project to the class, submit a final copy of the project by the deadline, participate in an Honors Scholars Panel or the Dr. Janet Liou-Mark Honors and Undergraduate Research Scholars Poster Presentation, and receive a grade of B or higher in the course. Copies of this contract should be retained by both the professor and the student to avoid any misunderstanding about the expectations for Honors credit. Upon completion of the course, the professor should report the student's grade to the Honors Scholars Program Coordinator.
